Chase Field Update –

Uniform Dress Code: The uniform is as follows: black pants (No jeans, jeggings, leggings, loungewear, or activewear.); black, SLIP RESISTANT shoes; black socks; a black belt; and a black t-shirt. The t-shirt must be all black, with no writing or logos, and will be visible to the customer. We will provide you with a black hat with the Diamondbacks logo. You have the option to purchase your own hat for \$5 or you can borrow a hat for your volunteer shift and return it at the end of each event. Lastly, Chase Field will provide each volunteer with a full-length apron: Red for Leads, Black with white stripes for Cashiers, White for Cooks. This apron will be worn during your volunteer shift and returned at the end of each event.

Parking: Employee parking is available on the East side of the ballpark off 9th Street. There is a discounted rate of \$5 to park in the employee lot so please come with cash on hand. Another option is to ride the light rail in if you would like. Either way, Booster Club will reimburse you for your parking or light rail fee before you leave at the end of your shift.

Lead and Assistant Lead Training: We need additional volunteers who are willing to work as Lead or Assistant Lead. If you are interested, please contact either Kristen or Nikki and they will get you set up to begin training.
