Downtown Parking – Is this a reimbursable expense? At whose expense?

Within the next two weeks we will be sending out a survey to vote on if we would like the club to reimburse up to a certain amount for parking. In order to do this, we would need to adjust the amount that is taken out the donations. We would only do this for rare crossover events when parking is hard to find and/or a ridiculous amount.

In the past when we did an event at Chase, they had a small lot that we paid \$5.00 to park at. Chase would then reimburse our club for the members that parked there. This allowed us to pay our members back for parking up to \$5.00.

\*\*Right now, there are many options for parking downtown. Some venues do offer free parking. On every gate list there will be information on parking. There is also free parking on the streets. The Light Rail offers rides during games at no cost with your ID badge. (The light rail runs 2 hours after a game.) Many of the parking garages offer monthly passes at a discounted rate.
