Old Business:

NASCAR - We only made \$6,233 this NASCAR, which ended up at \$5.84 an hour. Due to the weather there were low numbers of people and everyone made less money. There is a possibility of picking up more lemonade stands because the company that took them over needs help. We ran 1 of his stands on the weekend and made good money. We also need to consider giving up Midway. We have lost money on it every race. The general consensus is that even though we don't make lots of money, it is fun and at least we make something.

FRY'S – We will be sending out an email asking for reports from the members. The program is not as profitable as the prior one and the members have to report what they have made. We have no way of determining. Members need to send in a copy of their report from Fry's either by taking a picture of it with a phone, or emailing it.

SPRING TRAINING – Had a lot of issues with them, especially the supervisor the first weekend. After he was fired things go better, but they are much unorganized and it was really rough. BUT we did make a little over \$9 an hour which was good. The general consensus is we do it again next year if we can have the issues addressed and corrected. We are still working on resolving the \$1100 shortage that we were charged for throughout the season.

New Business:

Cardinals – The meeting with Sherry went very well. We gave up First Round Draft and in return got Sportsman Grille. This booth requires 2 more people to run but makes approximately \$50,000 more a year. It is open for Super Bowl, Fiesta Bowl and Pro Bowl where First Round is not. We also acquired a Sweet Cart which requires 3 people to run. We are also able to use 2 minors with the adult in this stand. That gives us the Red Dog, Sportsman Grille, Sweet Cart and the Draft Cart.
